BROOKLYN A's Low-Income Taxpayer Clinic (LITC) seeks law student interns who are interested in working with us during the Summer of 2018 to assist the LITC Director on current tax cases. Such work will include legal research and writing, as well as client interviewing and document review. Students will also assist with tax education and outreach in the community.

Applications will be accepted and processed on a rolling basis. Summer 2018 internships will likely begin in late May. Interns will be expected to work 40 hours per week for a minimum of ten weeks. Positions are not paid. BROOKLYN A is happy to assist students in obtaining internship funding via law schools, Equal Justice America or other organizations that are willing to fund the student.

Applications will be accepted by e-mail only, directed to internships@bka.org, and should include a cover letter, resume, unofficial law school transcript, and brief writing sample.
